In addition to the sights below, "add fabulous food to your vacation."

Ask your captain to consider visiting some of my favorite spots in Dalmatia:

1. **The Blaca Desert** on **Brač** island with its 15th century monastery carved in stone by hermit monks avoiding the Turkish invasion. Also on Brač, Jelsa for wine tasting at Dubokovič vineyard home of the Medvid grape.
2. **Zlatni rat** is the postcard jetty beach of Dalmatia and good for water sports. Center of all the fish varieties for me and not far from the source of the incredibly delicate Ston oyster.
3. **Korčula** Island and the birthplace of Marco Polo. Nearby **Moreška** hosts knight jousting tournaments in August. Famous local salami.
4. **Hvar** Island for lunch at Bilo Idro vineyard. Disco heaven!
5. **Biševo** Island and the Blue Cave and The Monk Seal cave for snorkeling.
6. **Vis** Island has fabulous rabbits and we can anchor in **Komiša**, the oldest fishing settlement in the Adriatic.
7. **Split** for local ducks (day#6 menu) and the 1700 year old Diocletian Palace, UNESCO site and the conclusion of The L'Avventura menu prepared by Chef Stephen Worsley.
